On Substance Use in the Age of Opioids

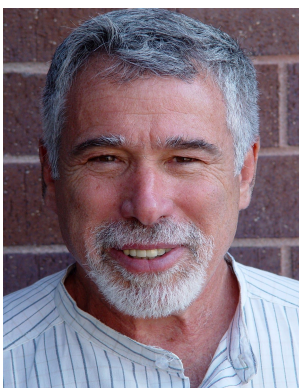

Prof. Milkman helped Iceland dramatically reduce its teen substance abuse rate through a long-term, multi-faceted approach, and his team of psychologists and other professionals is working with cities throughout Europe using the same approach.
